Our PTC will have a tent on site and everyone can swim and visit in an atmosphere with music and fun. Our teachers will be there to meet and greet in preparation for the year so be sure and say hello to your new teachers. Homeroom lists/House placements will be posted on the fences at the pool as well as on the front doors at CGIS. (The lists at the pool will be removed that night but we will leave the lists up on the front doors at CGIS in case you can't make it to the Block Party.)

Other Information to Rock the Start of School Year 2019!!!

Annual online verification/registration for returning Maryville City Schools families- You should have received an email from mcs.annualverification@maryville-schools.org asking you to complete verification of information for each of your students. Please complete this online task prior to the first day of school. If you can't find it, check your clutter as it could land there! Please see all information on this process and directions to complete the on-line process here.

School Based iReach Deployment- This year, iReach devices will be provided at each school site instead of a centralized deployment at Maryville High School. Returning families should complete online iReach tasks, which includes signing the RUP and payment. Please see all information on this process and directions to complete the on-line process here. CGIS students will receive their laptops on the second day of school. 5th-7th graders must bring their MCS sleeves to receive their devices. 4th graders and new students will receive sleeves with their laptops.

Tuesday, August 6- The First Day of School!!!!

This is definitely a day that we want to rock it and roll with it! Our school campus will be packed with cars and people with everyone experiencing the change that comes with a new school year. You can rock this day by being focused and ready to learn and roll with it by practicing patience and smiling through every situation. This is a great opportunity to stand out as a "Daymaker" for others by showing kindness and love.

Our front doors will open at 7 AM each school day. We will be serving breakfast in the cafeteria that morning from 7-7:30 AM. School starts at 7:40 AM and ends at 2:40 PM each school day.

All 4th/5th grade students will have a welcome assembly starting at 7:40 AM in the theatre and 6th/7th grade students will gather in the gym to prepare to "Rock It and Roll with It" this year. These Sorting and Hawk Way Beginning of Year assemblies usually last between 30-45 minutes. At the conclusion of these assemblies, core teachers will transition students to their respective house areas and begin our first Hawk Way Day of the year.

4th Grade Locker and Paperwork Night will occur after school from 4:30-6:30 PM at CGIS. This is an opportunity for 4th grader to bring those bulky school supplies to school with help from their parents (instead of hauling them in their backpack and grocery bags!). 4th grade students can decorate and organize their lockers with help from parents and this is a convenient time for parents to return paperwork that needs to be signed, pay any tuition or other fees, etc. Our 4th grade teachers, Mr. Cook and our 4th grade clerical staff will be hosting this event!

We suggest that 5th, 6th and 7th graders bring only their necessary supplies on the first day of school and then can bring in the bigger bulk supplies later in the week at the direction of their teachers. 5th graders will have a locker and paperwork night the following Monday so parents can choose to bring in those big bulk supplies on that night.

We will be sending home Friday Folders each week. For the first Friday of the school year, 5th, 6th & 7th grade students will be receiving any beginning of year paperwork that was not previously included in online verification and registration. 6th & 7th grade students should return completed paperwork to

school on Monday, August 12th. 5th graders should either return the completed paperwork/fees, etc. to school on Monday or attend 5th grade locker and paperwork night on Monday night, August 12th from 5:30-6:30 PM.
