Running Club Reminder



Just as a reminder, the new TN state guidelines regarding parent notes is different from prior years. The state is mandating that each day a student is out is counted as one parent note. If your student is absent for 4 days and you personally as their parent or guardian write a note that will encompass 4 of your 10 notes allowed per school year. Stricter requirements are in place for parent notes this school year.
