Core Academic Structure

Fourth grade students are a part of a team of approximately 50 students. They share 2 or 3 core teachers (Math/Science and RLA/SS Literacy).

At all other grade levels, students are a part of a team of 100 students and have four core teachers, one per academic subject.

School Wide Hawk Gatherings & 4th & 5th Grade Family Gatherings

- School wide Hawk Gatherings are held 4 times per year.
 - Show Up- August (Evening Event)- Show Up Nights
 - Own It-December (During School Event)- Hawk Holiday Gathering or International Children's Day Celebration
 - Achieve-March (During School Event)- Hall of Fame Events
 - Respect-May (During School Event)-Respect Games
- 4th/5th Grade Family Gatherings
 - Held on select Fridays around breakfast or lunch times
 - Opportunity for parents to eat lunch with children in our café and attend the Family Gathering in the Theatre





Encore Classes

- In the elementary school setting, these are referred to as specials.
- Encore classes are one hour in length each day and for 4th graders occur in the afternoon.
- We have an 8 day rotation that includes 2 Physical Education days, Art, Library, STEM, Music, Technology class, and Flight School for 4th graders.
- This rotation in 4th grade allows students to experience a variety of courses and informs them to be able to sign up for elective courses in 5th grade.
- 5th, 6th and 7th grade students are able to chose elective courses. These students will have electives on one day (Blue or Navy) and wheel classes on the alternating day.
