

What's new about next year?

Starting in 4th grade, students have the option of taking devices home

To take home devices, there is a \$40 user charge

- User charge helps with device maintenance
- User charge can be made in 2 installments (auto-pay or manually)
- Limited number of need-based scholarships available to cover half of user charge (select "Single \$20 half-payment" option for details)
- **Preferred way to register is online with e-check or credit card**

There is no Centralized Deployment at MHS – complete everything before hand, and student devices will be delivered to school. No summer commitments, no lines, no waiting.

4th Grade Deployment

- Signups are open now, and top priority is given to forms completed before school gets out this summer.
- Process starts at maryville-schools.org/ireach
 - Create an account at MySchoolBucks
 - Add [iReach](#) item to your cart and complete the online paperwork ([Securly](#), RUP, Media Release)
 - Payment Options: \$40 (1 time or payment plan, \$20 half-payment, \$0 Day User)
 - Repeat for any additional students in grades 4-12
 - Check out

Device Timeline



Now – May 17

Devices for students who complete Deployment during this window **will be delivered to schools on Day 1** of next school year. Device distribution process and timeline will be determined by individual schools.



After July 12

Devices for students who complete Deployment during this window **will be delivered to schools by the second week** of next school year.



17 May – 12 July

Devices for students who complete Deployment during this window **will be delivered to schools during the first week** of next school year.

What's the next step?



If you want to take care of this right now, you can download the MySchoolBucks app and do it on the spot.

As you tour after this meeting, one stop is the computer lab, where you can signup if you want and take care of this tonight. You can use a credit card or we also have the capability to take cash or a check!

If you'd rather wait till later, it can be done anytime following the instructions from maryville-schools.org/ireach

School Wide Hawk Gatherings & 4th Grade Family Gatherings

- School wide Hawk Gatherings are held 4 times per year.

- 4th Grade Family Gatherings
 - Held on select Fridays at the start of the day
 - Opportunity for parents to eat breakfast with children in our café and attend the Family Gathering in the Theatre

Encore Classes

- In the elementary school setting, these are referred to as specials.
- Some encore classes are one hour in length each day while others are thirty minutes. Encore classes for 4th graders occur in the afternoon.
- We have a weekly rotation that includes 2 Physical Education days, Art, Library, STEM, Music, Technology class, and Flight School.
- This rotation in 4th grade allows students to experience a variety of courses and informs them to be able to sign up for elective courses in 5th grade.
