Illness and Absences Information for Parents

We have seen an increase in absenteeism due to illness and we are taking all precautions to keep everyone healthy. As we weather this season of illness, here are a few reminders.

- If a student is feeling ill at school, he/she should contact a teacher or staff member so the student can be referred to our clinic for evaluation and parent contact. (Students should not call or text parents from cell phones for pick up. All students who become ill at school should visit the clinic prior to check out.)
- We recommend that students are fever free for 24 hours before the return of school and of course, follow your doctor's recommendations.
- Make Up Work- Students are expected to make up all work missed due to absences in a timely manner, regardless of the nature of the absence. Students have the responsibility for arranging make-up work with their teachers upon their return to school from an absence. Work missed due to absences of more than one day must be made up within the number of school days missed. If a student is absent, more than one day, the best way to access student assignments is through Canvas, OneNote, etc. and parents and students are encouraged to use this site for information about missed work. Parents and students may also email teachers for missed assignments. Teachers are not required to have make-up assignments available prior to prearranged absences.

We appreciate your proactive communication by sending email to update our teachers that your child will be out due to illness. Please continue to do so. We work to be timely in our response to emails, but with the number of students out, we may not be able to respond as quickly as we would

like. We encourage families to check online resources for make-up work. We, also, understand that your child may not feel well enough to do class work, so rest assured that we will do our best to catch them up upon his/her return. Thank you for your support at home, and we hope we can all stay well.
